The Three Sisters-North Truly Makes It "Three Sisters"

With the newest addition to: Tres Hermanas (located at 24th & K Street) and Three Sisters (located at Folsom Boulevard at 51st), THREE SISTERS-North truly is the third sister within the Mexican Restaurant Trio.

Norma, Dora, and Sonia *are* Tres Hermanas (Three Sisters) from Chihuahua, Mexico. They grew up on a farm in a small town and learned from an early age to work hard. In 1989, they came to Sacramento, California to find a better life for themselves. They started to work in a restaurant and after a few years they decided they wanted to open their own restaurant. In 1996, they opened Tres Hermanas in Midtown Sacramento. Norma and her mom would cook all the dishes in their own traditional way. Dora, Sonia, and their younger brother Sergio worked the front of the restaurant...and did anything that was needed to run the restaurant. In a few years, Tres Hermanas had developed a following with their traditional dishes and relaxed atmosphere. By 2000, an opportunity to open another location in East Sacramento surfaced.

The family decided to do something different by designing a Southwestern theme and offering Southwestern dishes, but still keeping most of the traditional dishes. They called this location "Three Sisters" and quickly became a great addition to the East Sacramento area. Both Tres Hermanas and Three Sisters have been great successes. Fourteen years after the opening of Tres Hermanas, Three Sisters - North has arrived!

Ingredients

- 2 cups dry elbow macaroni, cooked, rinsed, and drained
- 1/3 cup diced celery
- 1/4 cup minced red onion, soaked in cold water for 5 minutes, drained
- 1 tablespoon minced flat-leaf parsley
- 1/2 cup diced vine-ripened tomato (optional)
- 1/2 cup prepared mayonnaise
- 3/4 teaspoon dry mustard
- 1 1/2 teaspoons sugar
- 1 1/2 tablespoons cider vinegar
- 3 tablespoons sour cream
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt, plus more to taste
- Freshly ground black pepper



American Macaroni Salad

Most families have a favorite homemade recipe **macaroni salad**. But if you can't find your recipe box with those family heirlooms, then give this one a try! Some like a wetter salad, so they double the dressing recipe, others go the other way by using more macaroni. The choice is yours...and this recipe lets you make your own tradition. Try adding diced ham, bell peppers, pickles, leftover chicken or crispy bacon. The choices seem endless. Anyway you prepare it, Macaroni Salad is the perfect side dish everyone likes to eat.

Directions

In a large bowl combine the macaroni, celery, onion, parsley and tomato, if using. In a small bowl, whisk together the mayonnaise, mustard, sugar, vinegar, sour cream and salt. Pour the dressing over the salad and stir to combine. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Serve. Store covered in the refrigerator, for up to 3 days.
