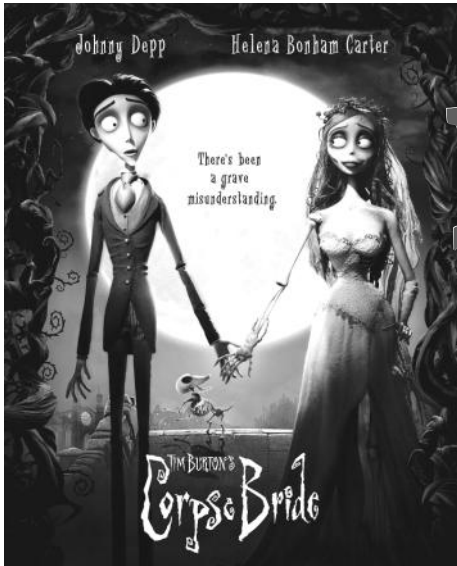

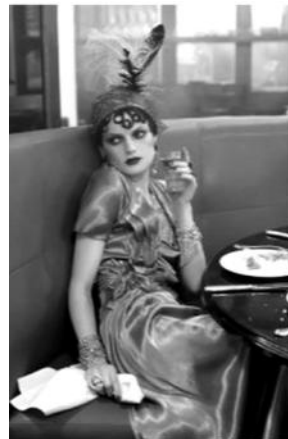

From Councilmember Sandy Sheedy

"I'm pleased to let you know that the Dixieanne Green Street project has received a prestigious international award from the European Center for Architecture, Art Design, and Urban Studies and the Chicago Athenaeum: Museum of Architecture and Design. The competition for the Good Green Design Award was very stiff - there were thousands of projects nominated from 46 different countries.

This is a great honor for the City of Sacramento, MIG, Inc., the consulting firm that designed the project, and the City's Department of Transportation team that brought the project on line.

I became interested in a project of this type as an inexpensive way to provide infrastructure for North Sacramento. In this case, we were able to install an effective stormwater runoff system that not only prevents flooding, but beautifies the neighborhood, and cleans the stormwater before it reaches our local streams and rivers.

When it was completed, this project was the longest green street in the nation, covering five blocks of Dixieanne Avenue, from Erickson to the Swanston Station Parking Lot.

If you have a chance, drive down Dixieanne Avenue and see it for yourself."

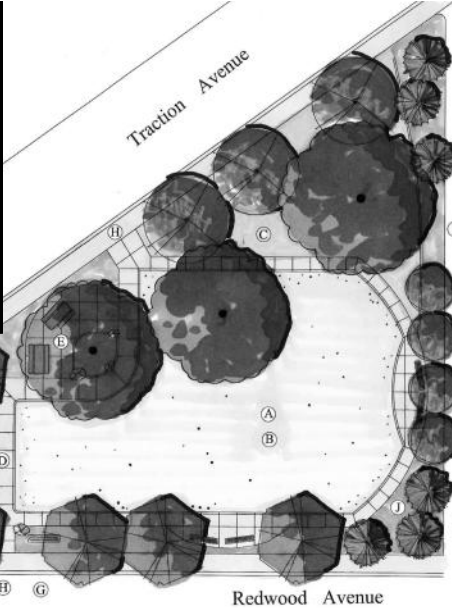

Affectionately known as

“Jack the Cop,” Officer Francis M. (Jack) Rea was a reassuring presence in the former City of North Sacramento - guarding school crosswalks, directing the PeeWee Baseball Little League, organizing volunteers to rebuild a damaged baseball field, and protecting North Sacramentans and their families. He carried Badge No. 1, which was retired in his honor after his tragic death in the line of duty in 1954.

REA PARK in North Sacramento bears the name of the late Police Officer Francis “Jack” Rea, who served his community well until his untimely death in the line of duty in 1954. Over the years, the park had fallen on hard times, and was rarely used by the children it was intended to serve.

The park has now received a makeover, and the final result is a fitting tribute to Officer Rea, who was known to the children of North Sacramento as “Jack the Cop.”
